## ----- TOOL: FARMING FOR DISSENT



We need to intentionally evaluate the conditions surrounding the change. To do so, we have to farm for dissent. We need to approach the stakeholders who will be impacted and look for the hurdles that exist and the behaviors that will occur. We do this upfront to ensure that we move into the change understanding all conditions.

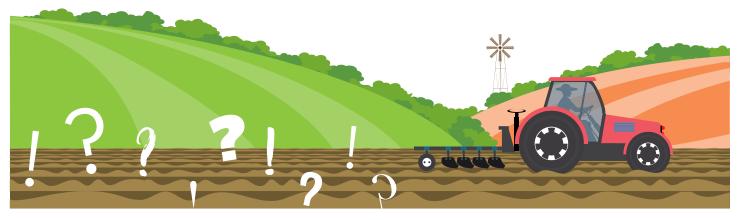
